DPA'S POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR SUCCESSFUL AND SAFE SUMMER CLASSES

- 1. Before leaving home, please make sure you are dressed and ready to go for your class. You **WILL** NOT be allowed to change clothes at the studio. The lobbies will be closed and bathrooms are only open for using the restroom. If you or a member of your family is feeling ill in any way, please stay home and Zoom the class.
- 2. Please bring <u>one</u> small bag for your dance shoes, water bottle, and phone (if applicable). Please bring your signed waiver form if you do not already have one on file. It can be found on the homepage of our website.
- 3. Please bring your own water as the water fountains will be closed. We will be selling a limited selection of drinks and snacks to those dancers who are here for two hours or more at a time, but they WILL NO LONGER be self-serve. You must let the front desk attendant know what you would like, and she will get it for you. You will then be directed to a designated eating space. For those students with us for dinner, you are allowed to bring a meal from home labeled with your name on it. Please leave it at the front desk upon arrival. It will be stored appropriately until your dinner break. The front desk attendant will assist you if you need the microwave.
- 4. Upon arrival to the studio, please find a place to park and remain in your car until 5 minutes before your scheduled class time. At this time, if your dancer is 8 years old or older, your child will make a line outside on the designated spaces by him/herself and enter the building one at time. A mask MUST be worn upon entering and exiting the building as well in common spaces while at DPA. (We will have some, but ask that you bring your own.) If your dancer is 7 years old or younger, the same procedures will be followed, but one adult chaperone is allowed to assist them inside.
- 5. Everyone that enters the studio will have their temperature taken at the front door. If your temp is 100.4 or higher, you will be asked to go home. You should stay home if you or anyone in your household is feeling sick. Once inside, everyone will sanitize before following the arrows upstairs and heading directly to their classroom. There will be signs and arrows to assist you.
- 6. Our lobbies will be CLOSED until further notice. After your dancer has gone up to class, you are free to go home or stay in your car for the duration of their class. Should you like to watch your child in class, please check our website for the Zoom links for each of our classrooms as each class will be live streamed.
- 7. Once in the classroom, dancers should find a distancing sticker/number on the outer edge of the room to place their belongings on and then put on their dance shoes. Although masks will not be required during our time dancing, they are highly encouraged. Each family should evaluate the best decision for their dancer before coming to camp. We have installed air scrubbers in all of our HVAC units to kill 99/9% of the bacteria in the air and on surfaces and the kids will be 6 feet apart. The teacher will then let dancers know when it is time to walk to their corresponding dance space.
- 8. When class is over, your dancer will return to his/her distancing square to put his/her mask back on and to change into street shoes. When everyone is ready to exit, the teacher will lead the class past the sanitation station and down the **back stairway** to the **back parking lot** where pick-up will be held. Should you be running late for pick-up, you <u>MUST</u> call the front desk to let us know. Your dancer will then be given a place to wait that is socially-distanced with the front desk attendant. During this time, teachers will be disinfecting each room.
- 9. **RESTROOMS**: Please use the restroom before you leave home. Our downstairs restrooms will be open, but are for emergencies only. Should you need to use the restroom, please let your teacher know, put on your mask, and sanitize on the way to the restroom <u>and</u> when you return to the classroom.
- 10. **STUDENTS WITH BACK-TO-BACK CLASSES**: These students will either exit the classroom, sanitize at the sanitation station, and wait in a socially-distanced space in Room # 5 or will remain in their classroom on their distancing sticker until their next classroom has been properly sanitized at which point they would exit and sanitize on route to their next class.

EXTRA: If you are uncomfortable with any of these procedures, we highly recommend taking classes from home on Zoom until you feel ready to join us. All of our classes will continue to be shared via Zoom from the studio until otherwise noted. Also, if your dancer is unable to comply with any of the above rules and procedures, he/she will be asked to leave and take class from home.

DPA'S POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR SUCCESSFUL AND SAFE CAMPS

- 1. Before leaving home, please make sure you are dressed and ready to go for your camp. You **WILL** NOT be allowed to change clothes at the studio. The lobbies will be closed and bathrooms are only open for using the restroom. If you or a member of your family is feeling ill in any way, please stay home and Zoom the camp.
- 2. Please bring <u>one</u> small bag for your dance shoes, water bottle, snack/lunch, and phone (if applicable). Please bring your signed waiver form if you did not turn one in at recital filming.
- 3. Please bring your own water as the water fountains will be closed. We will be selling a limited selection of drinks and snacks on our snack break. You must let your teacher know what you would like, and she will get it for you. Once everyone has his/her snack, your teacher will lead you back to your classroom to eat in your dance space. For those campers with us for double camps, you are allowed to bring a sack lunch from home, labeled with your name on it. Please leave it at the front desk upon arrival. We will store it appropriately until your lunch break.
- 4. Upon arrival to the studio, please find a place to park and remain in your car until 10 minutes before your scheduled camp time. At this time, if your camper is 8 years old or older, your child will make a line outside on the designated spaces by him/herself and enter the building one at time. A mask MUST be worn upon entering and exiting the building as well in common spaces while at DPA. We will have some, but ask that you bring your own.) If your camper is 7 years old or younger, the same procedures will be followed, but one adult chaperone is allowed to assist them inside.
- 5. Everyone that enters the studio will have their temperature taken at the front door. If your temp is 100.4 or higher, you will be asked to go home. You should stay home if you or anyone in your household is feeling sick. Once inside, everyone will sanitize before following the arrows upstairs and heading directly to their classroom. There will be signs and arrows to assist you.
- 6. *Our lobbies will be CLOSED until further notice.* After your camper has gone up to class, you are free to go home until pick-up time. Should you like to watch your child in camp, please check our website for the Zoom links for each of our classrooms. We will be livestreaming all camps.
- 7. Once in the classroom, campers should find a distancing square/number to place their belongings on and then put on their dance shoes (if they have them). Although masks will not be required during our time dancing, they are highly encouraged. Each family should evaluate the best decision for their dancer before coming to camp. (We have installed air scrubbers in all of our HVAC units to kill 99/9% of the bacteria in the air and on surfaces.) The teacher will let campers know when it is time to proceed to their corresponding dance space.
- 8. When camp is over, your camper will return to his/her distancing square to put his/her mask back on and to change into street shoes. When everyone is ready to exit, the teacher will lead the class past the sanitation station and downstairs to the parking lot where pick-up will be held. Should you be running late for pick-up, you MUST call the front desk to let us know. Your camper will then be given a place to wait that is socially-distanced during the lunch break. The staff will also take this time to disinfect each dance room.
- 9. **RESTROOMS**: Please use the restroom before you leave home. Our downstairs restrooms will be open, but are for emergencies only. Should you need to use the restroom, please let your teacher know, put on your mask, and sanitize on the way to the restroom <u>and</u> when you return to the classroom.
- 10. <u>STUDENTS WITH BACK-TO-BACK CAMPS</u>: These campers will exit the classroom, sanitize at the sanitation station, and come downstairs with the class. The campers leaving will exit and the campers eating lunch will be led to the socially-distanced waiting area until the teacher retrieves their lunches and takes them to where they will eat.

EXTRA: If your camper is unable to comply with any of the above rules and procedures, he/she will be asked to leave and not participate in camp.
